
The Party No. 1 enters into this agreement with the Party No. 2 subject to the under mentioned terms and conditions:


The Party No. 1 is responsible for confirming admission and for the conduct of examinations, evaluation and award of Degree to the enrolled students.




The Party No. 1 and Party No. 2 will mutually chart out the scheme of examinations for the programmes each year.
